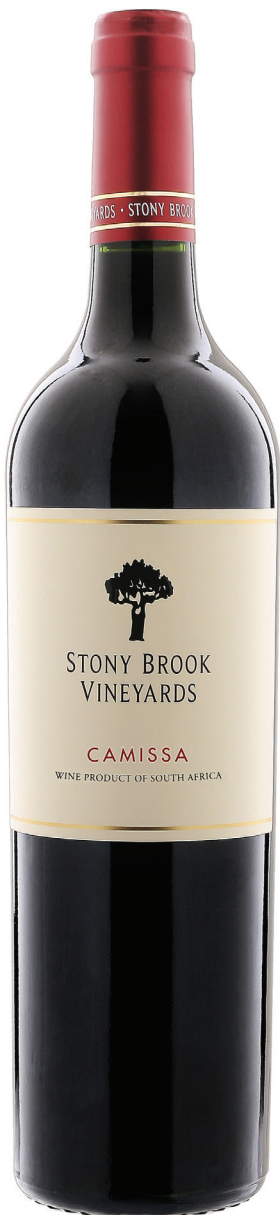




## CAMISSA 2021



### WINEMAKER'S NOTES

WINEMAKER: CRAIG McNAUGHT

Camissa means 'sweet water for all' in Kora, the Khoer language of the Cape. This refers to the river that runs from Table Mountain, under the city of Cape Town and into the Atlantic Ocean. This is a wine that is only produced every few years and its blend changes each time. The 2021 vintage is made up of only Franschoek-grown fruit; 81% Cabernet Sauvignon and 19% Petit Verdot - matured in 30% new French oak barriques for 24 months.

### TASTING NOTES

Classic aromatics of oak, chocolate, spice and leather punctuate the subtle cranberry fruit fragrance on the nose. The plush mid palate and delicate tannins perfectly balance the gentle acidity and light grip of the Cabernet Sauvignon. The body has effortless length and weight to it and delivers a beautifully dry but bright finish. Enjoy for up to twelve years from vintage as this wine's complexity develops.
